The 9th Brain-Storming Session of Vice Chancellors of the Agricultural Universities on 'Alternative Farming Systems Involving Horticulture to Increase Crop Productivity and Doubling Farmers' Income', was organised by Dr YS Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry, Nauni, Solan, Himachal Pradesh, in collaboration with Indian Agricultural Universities Association (IAUA), New Delhi, between May 3-4, 2018. Besides inaugural and valedictory sessions, five technical sessions were held on different sub-themes during the two days 'Brain Storming Session'.



- Technical Session I Mechanization and high density planting
- * Technical Session II Biotechnological approaches and cultivar development
- Technical Session III Integrated farming systems and marketing
- * Technical Session IV Nutrient and pest management in horticultural crops
- Technical Session V Natural/organic farming for sustainable crop production

The Chief Guest of the inaugural function was Shri Mahender Singh Thakur, Hon'ble Minister of IPH and Horticulture, Government of Himachal Pradesh. Shri Suresh Kumar Kashyap, MLA, Pachhad (Sirmour) was the Guest of Honour. Other dignitaries present on the occasion were Dr N C Patel, President, IAUA, Dr A R Pathak, Vice President, IAUA, Dr H C Sharma, VC, Dr YSP UHF, Nauni, Solan, Himachal Pradesh, and Dr R P Singh, Executive Secretary, IAUA. Twenty-one Vice Chancellors of various Agricultural Universities of India attended the 9th Brain Storming Meet. Several presentations were made

during the two day conference with a major focus on doubling farmers income through horticultural crops, climate resilient agriculture, and importance of agricultural education for food and nutritional security.

The 9th Brain-Storming Session of IAUA was inaugurated by Shri Mahender Singh Thakur, Hon'ble Minister of IPH and Horticulture, Government of HP in Dr L S Negi Auditorium of YSP UHF, Nauni, Solan by lighting the lamp, followed by Saraswati Vandana. Dr H C Sharma, VC, YSP UHF, Nauni, welcomed the dignitaries on the dias, participating Vice Chancellors, and the guests to the 9th Brain Storming Session. He briefed the audience about the activities and achievements of YSP UHF in horticulture and forestry. He also highlighted the role of State Agricultural Universities in strengthening the agricultural education in India, and the research and extension initiatives to sustain productivity and ensure food sufficiency for the ever-growing population.

The first technical session on 'Mechanization and High Density Planting' was organized in the Committee Room, VC Office, YSP UHF, Nauni, Solan. The chairperson Col (Dr) AR Pathak welcomed the guest speakers and shared his views on the sub-theme of the session. Two presentations entitled, 'Mechanization in horticulture: Potentials and limitations' by Dr N C Patel, VC, AAU, Anand, and 'High density plantations of temperate fruits for increasing farm income' by Dr Nazeer Ahmed, VC, SKUAST (K), Srinagar, were made during this session.



Based on the deliberations and discussion, the following recommendations were made during this session.

- Mechanization of cultural operations, especially for small and marginal farmers of hilly regions.
- Set up 'State of Art Tissue Culture Laboratories' for production of quality planting material.
- Effective pollination management for increasing fruit set and crop yields.
- Develop systems for high density planting of fruit crops.

The second technical session on 'Biotechnological Approaches and Cultivar Development' was organized in the Conference Hall, Deventure Hotel, Kandaghat, Solan. Dr BS Dhillon, Chairperson, thanked Dr HC Sharma, VC, YSP UHF, for organizing the 9th Brain Storming Session and welcomed the guest speakers. He highlighted the need for a professional approach based on actual field data, while dealing with environmental and policy issues pertaining to

modern agricultural practices. Two presentations entitled 'Potential for application of biotechnological approaches in horticultural crops' by Dr H C Sharma, VC, YSP UHF, Nauni and 'Development of cultivars for protected cultivation of vegetable crops' by Dr A S Dhatt, Senior Vegetable Breeder-cum-Head, Department of Vegetable Science, PAU, Ludhiana, were made during this session. The recommendations made during the session were as follows:



- Use of biotechnological tools for production of new cultivars with disease and pest resistance and quality traits in horticultural crops, with emphasis on dwarf rootstocks.
- Need to educate people about biosafety of GMOs, and place emphasis on developing cultivars with drought and cold tolerance, and nutritional enrichment.
- Developing vegetable varieties suited for poly-house cultivation in collaboration with seed industry.
- Validation of polyhouse structures for different agro-climatic regions.
- Standardization of hydroponic systems for production of vegetables/ flowers.

- Validation and popularization of region specific Integrated Farming System (IFS) models for enhancing the farmers' income.
- Scaling-up 'Cluster Based Integrated Farming' through resource sharing.
- Utilization of horticultural waste for feeding livestock and improving soil health.
- Need to increase farmers' share in consumer rupee through better market regulation.
- Strengthening of infrastructure for supply chain, marketing, and to reduce post harvest losses.


