MANDATE

The Indian Agricultural Universities Association (IAUA) is a Registered Society under Registration no. 3498 of 10 November 1967. It was established in November 1967 with nine agricultural universities as its founder members, viz. PAU, Chandigarh (now Ludhiana); APAU (now ANGRAU), Hyderabad; JNKVV, Jabalpur; UPAU (now GBPUAT), Pantnagar; UAS, Bangaluru; KU, Kalyani university (now BCKV, Mohanpur); OUAT, Bhubaneshwar; (now MPUAT), Udaipur; and IARI, New Delhi.

During this long span there has been phenomenal increase in the number of member universities, especially during the late 90s and onwards. At present the strength of the IAUA membership is 55, including 47 state agricultural universities, 5 deemed-to-be universities (IARI, IVRI, NDRI, CIFE and SHIATS) and 3 central agricultural universities (CAU, Imphal; BHU, Varanasi and BAU, Sabour). All these are regular members of the Association.

The main objective of the Association is to promote agricultural research, education and extension in the universities and the states, and thereby rural development in the country. It also acts as a bureau of information to facilitate communication, co-ordination and mutual consultation among the agricultural universities. The Association also acts as a liaison between member universities and government departments to facilitate communication and expedite the needed action in important matters.

All the SAUs and institutions (deemed-to-be universities) and CAUs (Central Agricultural Universities) in India, which provide an integrated programme of teaching, research and extension education in agricultural sciences, are qualified to become regular members of the Association.

The vice-chancellors of member universities constitute Association's General Body. The General Body meets once a year to decide the agenda for the next convention and also to adopt its audited accounts of the year as well as approval of budget estimates for the next financial year, besides the election of office-bearers for the following calendar year. The Executive Committee of the Association consists of President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer and three members. The Executive Committee meets quarterly.

The office of the Association is manned by Secretary General, who implements the decisions of General Body and Executive Committee on behalf of the Association. A quarterly newsletter is also being published by the Association since 2000, giving important news, events and achievements by member universities for the information of all the members and other persons interested.

The main source of revenue of the Association is the annual subscription from member universities. The ICAR also provides a nominal grant annually.

EVENTS

Fourth Brain-storming session:

Fourth Brain-storming session was held during 5-6 August 2011 at College of Agriculture, Nagpur, hosted by VC, PDKV, Akola. The session was on "Human resource assessment in relation to working and output in agricultural universities"

The major recommendations of the session are given below:

- 1. To attract young talent to agricultural education.
- 2. To increase the number of Junior or Senior Research Fellowships.
- 3. To establish Central Agricultural University in each state.
- 4. To build the capacity of entry-level teachers in SAUs.
- 5. To provide international exposure of teachers in SAUs.



6. To establish Agro-Industrial Training Institutes and polytechnics.
7. To strengthen grain storage and introduce more in mechanize research in SAUs.
8. To provide catch-up grant for strengthening central instrumentation facilities.
9. To support hill agriculture.
10. To upgrade the position of Programme Co-ordinator in KVKs.
11. To strengthen subject matter specialists in KVKs of SAUs.
12. Capacity building of KVK staff.
13. To provide the position of library staff.
14. To continue modernization scheme of AU farms.
15. To outsource the use of IT applications.
16. To establish training institute for administrative and finance staff.
17. To arrange e-governance and paperless office.
18. NAARM should organize 2 day programme for vice-chancellors on administration.
19. To increase the contingency grant to AICRP to Rs 1.50 lakhs per scientist.

Thirty Sixth Annual convention of Vcs

The 36th Annual Convention of the VCs was held during 13-14/12/2011 at AAU, Jorhat (Assam).

The major recommendations are given below:

1. To identify the centres of excellence and niche areas in SAUs to be sent to the ICAR for funding.
2. To integrate the ELP in the faculty of various disciplines, including veterinary and fishery sciences in the Aus.
3. To change the by-laws of IAUA, for any reform in the by-laws.
4. To frame rules for undergraduate and post-graduate students to facilitate their migration within the SAUs.
5. To identify problems of AICRP projects such as the impact on smooth running of projects due to abolition of permanent positions, timely distribution of funds etc.
6. To ensure pay structure of the SMS equal to that of the teachers.
7. To re-vamp the PG research and uniformity in the date of admission across the SAUs to facilitate migration of students.
8. The ICAR should include SAUs in their network projects to conduct research work in frontier areas of agricultural sciences for the benefit of Indian farming community.
9. To increase the number and amount of scholarships or fellowship for the UG and P.G. programmes in SAUs for the benefit of the students.



LINKAGES

The Association expanded its linkages with international sister Associations, like Asia-Pacific Association of Agricultural Research Institutions (APAARI), Bangkok. Asian Association of Agricultural Colleges and Universities, Philippines and signed MoU with National Chung Hsing University, Taichung, Taiwan and National University of Life and Environmental Sciences of Ukraine, Ukraine. This will facilitate global exchange of views and knowledge in the field of agricultural research, extension and education.

FINANCE, BUDGET AND AUDIT REPORT

The main source of revenue of the Association is the subscription from member universities. In addition, the ICAR also provides a nominal assistance of Rs 10 lakhs annually for organizing national - level events like Annual conventions, National symposia and Brain-storming sessions etc.

The audited statement of Accounts for the year 2011-12 (**Annexure 1**) reveal that total income of the Association is **Rs 35,19,039** (Rupees Thirty Five Lakhs Nineteen Thousand and Thirty Nine only) through (i) Rs. 27,49,850 as membership subscription, (ii) Rs7,69,189 as interest from bank; out of which Rs. 10,00,000 as grant from the ICAR received during April 2012 and hence not included in the receipt; and total expenditure Rs 31,58,109 (Rupees thirty one lakh fifty eight thousand one hundred and nine only). At the close of the financial year 2011-12, the Association has **fixed deposits of Rs 86,66,428** (Rupees eighty six lakhs sixty six Thousand only), which will be **Rs 1,11,53,854 as on 28 November 2014**.
